The Exergen TemporalScanner is an infrared thermometer that can read body temperatures in 2 seconds, according to Exergen Corp. It works by capturing naturally emitted heat from skin over the temporal artery, which runs across the forehead and is directly connected to the heart via the carotid artery. The thermometer retails for less than \$50 and is available at Wal-Mart and drugstores nationwide.

"Research proves that this is one of the most accurate ways to test for fever in all ages and it is clearly the least invasive," says Exergen Corp. president Francesco Pompei, who developed and patented the technology.
